Learn the fine art of men's tailoring from Bay Area Costume Designer and SFSU instructor using a standard 19th century pattern to create a single breasted "Dickens" appropriate frock coat. Intensive sessions will be devoted to creating a custom fit coat combining classic tailoring and speed tailoring techniques. Sewing skills are a must and a commitment to home work between classes will be required. Class size will be a minimum of 8 and limited to 12. Basic pattern in appropriate size included.

MATERIALS TO BRING:

1. Materials: 5 yards of wool suit weight flannel and any contrast fabric such as velvet for the collar and cuffs and satin for the lapels and a "Jacket Packet" in appropriate size, which must be ordered ahead of time. Allow \$200.00 as a material cost.

2. Sewing Machine and related sewing tools including scissors, polyester thread and 80/12 needles.

3. Hand tailoring tools including chalk marking pencil, point turner, tape measure, tracing paper, seam gauge and ripper, pins, tailoring ham.

On registration a complete material checklist will be provided.

INSTRUCTOR: After receiving his MFA in Theatre from California Institute of the Arts, Todd Roehrman has designed costumes for theatre and dance companies on the West Coast from Seattle to San Diego. He has been honored for his work with multiple awards, currently serves as professor of Costume Design at San Francisco State University, teaches workshops to small groups and individuals in silk flower making techniques and operates a private atelier in San Francisco for custom work in theatre, film, industrials and private clients.
