An early Italian form of needle lace, worked within an evenweave fabric where select threads are removed, the resulting voids becoming the focus of needleworked geometric designs.

Requiring only a sewing needle, fabric and a thread, you can create exquisite lace, reminiscent of Reticella, Hedebo, and Hardanger. In this class you will create a simple pattern, learning the basic techniques.

BRING: Reweaving needle or tapestry needle,
5" or 6" hoop,
sharp pointed embroidery
scissors.
