Up until the later part of the 18th Century the most popular hat perched on ladies heads was the Bergere (French for Shepherdess.) This millinery mainstay was very versatile and extremely flattering. It consists of a shallow crown and a wide, flat brim. It can be worn with the brim folded back, turned up or down, ribbon ties under the chin or behind the head. It lends itself to lovely folded ribbon decoration around the crown and brim. No matter how you decide to wear it, this hat looks terrific on everyone. The object of this class is for the attendee to learn correct millinery technique so that they may continue to make hats on their own.

INCLUDED IN KIT:

Hand blocked buckram crown to cover (choice of small or large crown)
1/2 yard white French fleece (mulling)
Millinery wire, Millinery joiner, Curved needle
Double buckram for one hat

TO BRING:

Portable zig-zag sewing machine, Several size 14 or 16 sewing machine needles
Scissors, one for fabric, one for buckram and poster board, Wire cutter
Clear plastic 18" ruler, Pins, Marking chalk, Pencil, Hand sewing needles
Thread: 1 all purpose white, 1 all purpose to match fashion fabric, 1 heavy to match fashion fabric.
1 pkg white, single fold, 1/2inch, bias tape, ironed flat.
Fabri-Tac glue, 2 pieces of poster board (to copy patterns) available at Target
*** Fabric: You'll need to invest in a solid color Silk Taffeta. 1/2 yard of at least 45" wide
