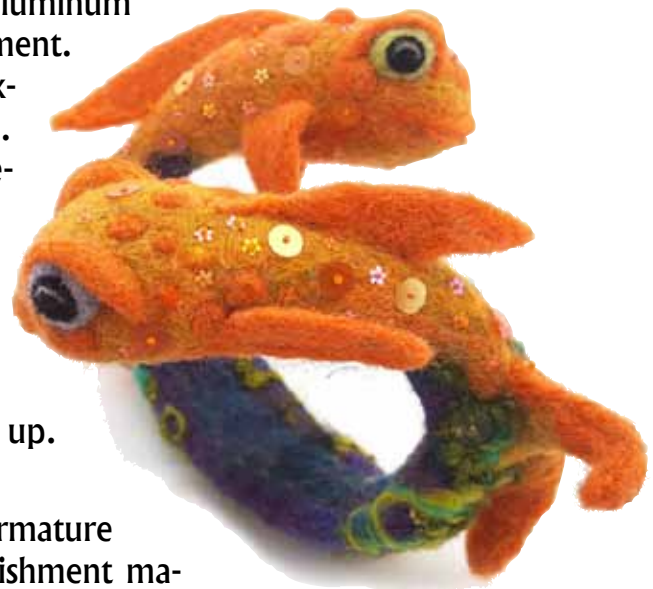
You will start with felt sheet, worked over aluminum armature wire to create a base for embellishment.

The aluminum is very thick, but soft and flexible, creating a bracelet that can be shaped. You will learn about the structure of needle-felted wool and how to create a firm, homogenous material that can be carved into for sharp details. Tips and tricks for creating durably edged thinner pieces, like the fins, are useful for many other designs.

The class is suitable for all levels, ages 14 and up.

INCLUDED IN KIT:

Wool, custom made needle felting tools, armature wire, printed felting information and embellishment materials.
