INSTRUCTOR: Janyce Engan has been teaching various forms of sewing and needlework in the Bay Area for over 20 years, blending a deep grounding in vintage fashion and an extensive knowledge of a wide range of techniques together with a liberal dash of good humor and patience.

Janyce is the owner of the “Vintage Pattern Lending Library” established for the purpose of preserving, archiving, and replicating historic fashion patterns from 1840 through 1950, vintage sewing publications, and fashion prints of the past.
