See the ribbon jump to life as you ruffle together the pleated ribbon and insert tiny balls of cotton and stamens to be nestled within each bloom.

These dainty delights are the perfect size to be used as a fob on the end of a delicate embroidery scissor or zipper pull. Create a cluster and wear them as a brooch or use them as fringe on any number of things. Shorten the gimp and they can be turned into delightful dangling earrings. There are endless ideas and uses for these fanciful fuchsias flowers.

TOOLS; To bring

- o Tape measure, Note taking materials
- o Embroidery or Sharp sewing scissors
- o Scissors to cut French wire-edged ribbon,
- o Needles (I like Milliners needles best),
- o Straight pins (longer ones with ball head – like quilters pins - easiest to work with)
