You will learn how to pattern, sew and mount a fabric bag onto a metal frame, as would be carried in the period of mid 19th Century, thru Edwardian and up to the 1930s.

PROVIDED BY INSTRUCTOR:

Handouts, drafting tools and pattern paper, a selection of standards patterns

TO BRING:

A vintage period frame or choose from a wide selection available at Lacis. A list of recommended frames is available at the Museum shop. If using your own frame, contact teacher prior to class.

Sewing machine, basic fabric sewing, cutting and drafting tools, small 2" curved needle.

Outer Fabric for day purse: Cotton velvet, silk or rayon fraille or a light weight tapestry fabric.

Outer Fabric for an evening bag: Silk velvet or beaded silk fabric.

Lining: Silk taffeta preferred or any other fine silk.

Interfacing: Light weight cotton fabric.

INSTRUCTOR:

Taught to sew at a very early age, she merged her talents for computer drafting with her love for sewing, creating a line of hat patterns, "OUT OF A PORTRAIT, HAT PATTERNS," www.lynnmcmasters.com. She has designed patterns and made period costumes for dolls and people, and has taught costuming for GBACG, Costume College in Los Angeles, and in various venues near her home in Santa Cruz.
