In this class you will learn some of the techniques used in making Turkish "Oyas," the decorative endings of scarves. These patterns will then be used to create lovely delicate bracelets.

It is essential that you are a competent crocheter. We will be doing some complicated techniques working with a small gauge threads. You must know how to chain, slip stitch, single and double crochet. If you can read diagrams - great - but no worry - if not I will teach you and will provide written instructions.

Bring: (2) balls #10 cotton cordonnet (color to compliment the beads you choose))  
crochet hook #6  
Tapestry needle  
Scissors  
(100) #6 or #8 pre-strung beads for each bracelet.  
(2) Special buttons to compliment your beads and thread color.

**INSTRUCTOR:** Mirto is an adventurous fiber artist with a passion for crochet which she has been doing for over 40 years, exploring different techniques and dimensions. She has studied and taken workshops with Prudence Mapstone, Maire Treanor and Myra Woods.
