Irish crochet is the technique of freeform lace where motifs are initially made and then joined together to form the final design. In this class you will learn to make the classic Irish Rose, explore other traditional motifs. and learn to read crochet diagrams.

It is essential that you are adept at the basic crochet stitches: chain, slip stitch, single crochet, half double crochet and double crochet.

Bring:

#10 cotton cordonnet (ecru or white)  
crochet hook #12 - #6  
scissors  
tapestry needle

**INSTRUCTOR:** Mirto is an adventurous fiber artist with a passion for crochet which she has been doing for over 40 years, exploring different techniques and dimensions. She has studied and taken workshops with Prudence Mapstone, Maire Treanor and Myra Woods.
