The embroidery of Haute Couture, has become one of today's most popular techniques. It is particularly suitable for bead and sequin work, it is fast to execute and encourages freedom of design. Handout materials, patterns and initial working thread provided by instructor.

THE FIRST SESSION: After a brief history and examination of tambour work, you will be introduced to the tools, set up and use of the unique needle. By the end of the session you will be attaching beads and sequins to your working organza fabric.

THE SECOND SESSION: Working on a selected design, perfecting technique, introduction to new stitches and developing design ideas.

Kit includes: LF90 Professional Frame, #90 Tambour Needle and Handle, Silk Organza, 2 strands of seed beads [25% discount by LMLT]

Bring: Small scissors, sewing needle, fine 1-1/4" pins, fabric pencil, small tray for beads, frat check.
