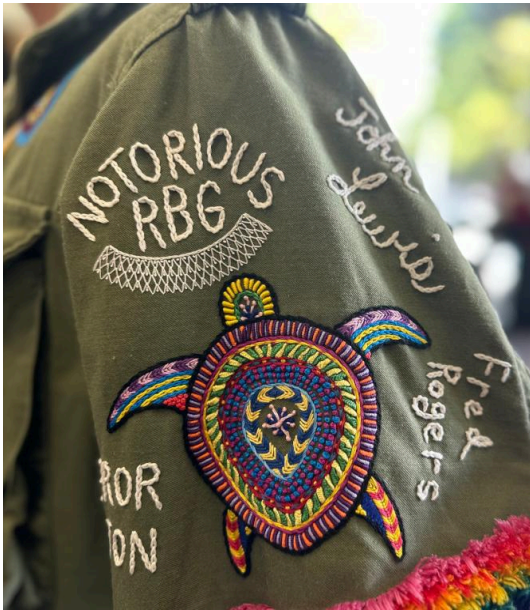


EXPRESS YOURSELF STITCH BY STITCH WITH
